ABOUT SPRUCE LAKE

Owned and operated by the Franconia Mennonite Camp Association, Spruce Lake was founded in 1963 and has been a ministry of Christian Hospitality to hundreds of thousands of guest groups and individuals. Our ministries are Christ-Centered and include: **Outdoor School** for Christian Schools, **Program** Events for families, special needs groups, and individuals, a **Resident Wilderness Camp** for ages 7-18, and a **Day Camp** for ages 5-15.

We are a non-profit organization devoted to sharing the good news of Jesus Christ. Our Core Purpose is...

“Pointing People toward Christ.”

Our Statement of Faith and Core Values are as follows:

These core values are grounded in our Statement of Faith as summarized below:

Spruce Lake Retreat is dedicated to Christian service in the Anabaptist tradition. With all who live by faith in Jesus Christ, we believe

- In one God eternally existing as Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
- That God has revealed himself in the Scriptures of the Old and New Testaments, the divinely inspired, entirely trustworthy, relevant, and authoritative Word of God.
- That in the beginning God created all things by His Son.
- That all people have sinned, bringing death and separation from God.
- In restoration with God through repentance and the shed blood and resurrection of the Lord Jesus Christ, by grace through faith apart from works.
- That the Holy Spirit convicts of sin, effects the new birth, gives guidance in life, empowers for service, and enables perseverance in faith and holiness.
- That Jesus, when he lived on earth, revealed a way for people to live peacefully as devoted servants of God.
- That the church is the body of Christ, a people redeemed and striving to be obedient to the Word of God, in a fellowship of love, intercession, and healing.
- That the goodness of being single or married is honorable. We believe that God intends marriage to be a covenant between one man and one woman for life. According to Scripture, right sexual union takes place only within that heterosexual marriage relationship.
- That Jesus Christ will come again to gather his church, and judge all people. God will reign with Christ in justice, righteousness, and peace forever.

Integrity

We will be transparent in our relationships, practices, and attitudes, including being honest with each other even when to do so may cause us or another initial pain. We will be accountable first to God and then to each other to live and work in a way that points people to Christ, establishing expectations that fit within the reality of our mission, time, resources, and staffing levels.

Set aside for Christian nurture, recreation and fellowship!

The Retreat Center is in constant motion serving families and groups in the spirit of Christian hospitality! As many as 600 guests at a time come and go in our seasonal campground, hotel-style rooms, or self-contained lodges.

Spruce Lake designs a variety of our own retreats to meet the diverse needs of families and adults, including: Family Events, Music Weekends, and Seniors Events. Spruce Lake also hosts Joni & Friends Family Retreats and Christian Overcomers, partnering in their ministries to individuals and families with special needs.

Retreat Center guests are looking for recreation, comfortable, clean lodging, and renewed fellowship with the Creator, His creation, and each other. Working at the Retreat Center is a perfect opportunity to demonstrate the love of Christ as you serve and interact with guests.

WILDERNESS CAMP

Using wilderness adventures to point young people toward Christ.

Summer camps and expeditions provide a place where campers ages 7-18 are touched by the love of Jesus and the wonder of God's Creation. Up to 160 campers arrive Sunday afternoon and stay through Friday evening.

At Wilderness Camp, counselors and campers share a platform tent. They participate in age-appropriate activities, spiritually challenging Firesides and new friendships.

On Expeditions, campers and their guides participate in backpacking, canoeing, biking, and spiritual growth-driven Life Searches in the midst of God's creation. At each level, youth are challenged to deepen relationships with others, with God, and with His creation.

Wilderness Camp children want to relate to young adults who are fun, understanding, level-headed, and genuine. They want to see that Christian faith is relevant in today's world. Working at Wilderness Camp is a great opportunity to disciple young people for God's Kingdom.
